Arranging Your Transportation

You will indicate your transportation choice (Drop –off or bus) in the online parent center. While many parents will drop their child off at camp, we do offer bus transportation alternatives. If no transportation is scheduled in the parent center the camper will be automatically listed as a car drop off and pick up. All changes in transportation must be made in writing, emailed to transportation@paliadventures.com. Changes made less than two weeks prior to the arrival or departure will result in an additional fee of \$50.00. NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE UNLES THE PAYMENT HAS BEEN CHARGED. There is no refund on transportation fees if the change has been made within two weeks.

No child will be permitted to leave camp with anyone other than their parent or guardian without written consent from their parent or guardian. Consent can be provided through the parent center.

Communication Regarding Delays, Changes and Emergencies.

If unforeseen circumstances or any kind of emergency may affect a scheduled pick-up or drop-off time or location Pali's Transportation Director will call the primary cell phone listed for each camper that may be affected. If the call is not received a voicemail will be left when possible and other phone numbers and/or email addresses may be called or emailed to ensure that updated information has been passed on.

Bus Transportation

Pali Adventures offers three bus pick up and drop off locations. The cost for this service is \$50.00 each way.

Bus Pick Up (Sunday's / Arrival Day)

Buses to camp will depart from Fashion Valley Mall and South Coast Plaza at 10:00am sharp on Sunday mornings. Buses to camp from Aidan's Place at Westwood will depart at 12:00pm sharp. Please plan your arrival at least 15 – 30 minutes prior to departure. If you are running late to the pick-up location, please call Pali and ask for the Transportation Director. Lunch will be provided at camp. A light snack and bottled water is recommended for the journey. Pali will email all parents when the buses arrive at Pali. Please read our Transportation Rules for buses located at the bottom of this document.

Bus Departure (Saturday's / Departure Day)

The buses will arrive at the drop off locations at 12:00pm on Saturday's. Please plan your arrival 15 – 30 minutes early. Please remember to pick up your camper's luggage! Typically, campers do not pack as well as parents and may have more bags than when they arrived at camp. Pali will inform parents if the bus is running more than 15 minutes late by calling the primary cell phone on file for each camper. Please have your ID ready. Pali will check to make sure the campers leave with an identified parent or guardian. If someone other than a parent or guardian will be collecting your child from the drop off location, please make sure you send an email to the Transportation Director at transportation@paliadventures.com. We will not release a camper to a non-custodial adult without written permission.

Airport Travel

Pali will only provide transportation to the airport at the end of camp.

- Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) \$120.00. Approximately 90 minutes – 2 hours from camp.
- Ontario International Airport (ONT) \$50.00. Approximately 45 minutes – 1 hour from camp.

Arriving Flight Time Recommendations

In order to reduce the amount of airport waiting time, please plan your child's departing flights between 10:00am and 2:00pm Pacific Time where possible.

The luggage will be delivered to your child's cabin upon their arrival. Please send return labels or pay the additional baggage fees for the return journey.

Transportation Rules for Arrival & Departure

Pali Adventures primary concern is for the safety of the campers in our care. For that reason, we would like to bring to attention the following rules for our buses and vans. Thank you in advance for your understanding and for sharing this information with your camper.

- No excessive noise or rowdiness.
- No horseplay.
- No body parts are permitted outside of the vehicle.
- In the case of buses, campers and staff are to remain in their seats and not standing in the aisles. When being transported in a camp vehicle (bus, van) all passengers must remain seated when the vehicle is moving.
- Make sure that all doors are locked before departing.
- Throwing litter from a vehicle is prohibited.
- Camper and staff are not to load or unload vehicles while ignition is on and the vehicle's engine is running. Small camp vehicles are loaded in the parking lot. Large buses are usually loaded in the Hot Zone.
- Throwing objects is prohibited.
- Playing music at a volume that distracts the driver is prohibited.
- Walking on a public street is prohibited unless accompanied by at Pali staff member.
- Behavior unacceptable in camp will not be tolerated outside of camp.
